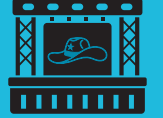

GETTING AROUND



Every 5 Minutes

MARTA trains will run every 5 minutes on match days (until 10:30 p.m.)



75%+ Slower

Traffic around the stadium may lead to significant slowdowns compared to the speed you'd move with no traffic.



10 Minute Walk

To accommodate larger numbers of people on foot, Uber and Lyft will pick up and drop off about a half mile from the stadium.



3 Hours

Stadium congestion can begin 3 or more hours before a match, with traffic peaking about 1 hour before match start.

Match Day Busy Times

EXPECT DELAYS

Plan your commute to avoid the crowd - Commuter earlier or later on match days, especially near the stadium and Centennial Olympic Park. Or flex a work-from-home day if you can!



Expect Surprises

Teams, world leaders, and other VIPs will be traveling around the region, and police escorts are more likely to complicate commutes than stadium crowds. Plan to avoid the most likely times for these delays, but also expect surprises!
